Finca Antigua Blanco DO, La Mancha, Spain, grape variety: Viura

With a lot of passion and commitment, it did not take long for the wines to develop from insider tips to absolute top wines. And so the loyal clientele grew continuously. In the meantime, Micha and Luca - the sons of Andrea and Marianne Davaz - are the third generation to work in the winery and ensure that tradition, values and craftsmanship are carried into the future.



Fabelhaft Branco, Niepoort Vinhos, Douro

The Fabelhaft Branco is a good example of Niepoort's philosophy thanks to its taut and mineral character. It presents itself fresh, with flavours of herbs and citrus fruits. Despite its youth, it suggests great potential. A wine full of finesse and elegance with an electrifying finish that won't let you go. The grapes are transported chilled to Quinta de Nápoles, where they are carefully selected and then pressed. Spontaneous fermentation takes place at a controlled temperature in stainless steel tanks. The wine then matures for six months on the fine lees.The storyIn order to express the character of the Douro in a white wine, Dirk Niepoort climbed high up in search of vineyards with indigenous grape varieties grown on mica schist and expressing the character of the rocky valley.

The local microclimate still shapes the taste of the characteristic wine and provides the basis for the development of the grape varieties. This wine-growing community is unique in South Tyrol, the vineyards are at 220 to 900 meters above sea level. Excellent wines are made in the vineyard.
